HANIP: You can start off by fitting larger alloys and a body kit together. There are many large alloys out there that can compliment the look of your car. As for body kits, there are many reputable Japanese brands that design and make bodystyling kits for the Wish like Fabulous. Your choices are basically limitless with the parts available out there.

But I'm not sure entirely about how it looks though – I find that the rear end, with those big tail lamps a bit too heavy and clumsy.
