



'Ask Hanip'

Hi, my 2006 Yaris 1.5A is approaching my 40,000km servicing soon and I'm clueless as to what is needed to change, replaced or serviced. Is there any specific item or oil needed when my car hits 40,000km? Thanks again! – Joe

Hi Joe, for a car's 40,000km servicing, there's no need to worry as it's just the usual stuff that need to be replaced like engine oils, spark plugs and the oil filter. If you want to go a step further you might want to change your ATF and ATF

filter as well. Do you're your mechanic to check your brake pads to ascertain their condition, as we all have varying driving habits, some might need to get change their brake pads, other don't. Another good area to look into is the A/C filter, again this depends on condition. If your a/c is not blowing as strongly as before, or if there's a funny smell, there's a good chance your a/c filter is due for a change. In addition, you'll probably need to change you air-intake filter if it's stock and brake-fluid too!
